Biography: Dr. Robert P. McGowan



Dr. Robert P. McGowan has taught strategic planning, managing innovation and change, strategic human resource management and leadership to many managers and executives, including US West, TCI, Great Western Life, Microsoft, and the US Office of Personnel Management. He has also taught entrepreneurship to officials and business executives from Taiwan, Russia, Korea, People's Republic of China, South Africa, Greece, and Italy.

Dr. McGowan is Professor and Chair of the Department of Management at the University of Denver's Daniels College of Business. He has taught at Pennsylvania State University and is on the faculty of the University of California at Berkeley's Worldwide Education Program.

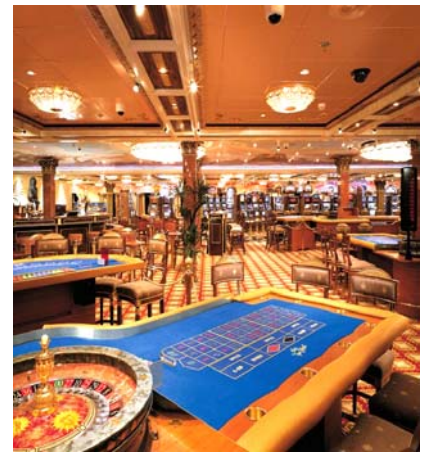
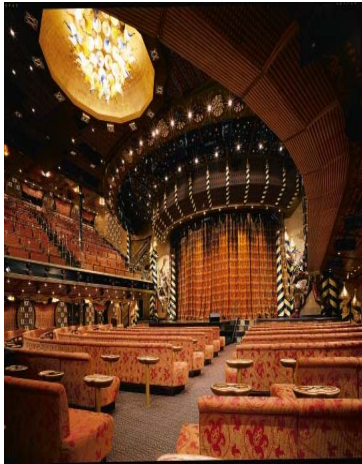
Areas of expertise also include customer service, the strategic management of technology, issues management, joint ventures and strategic alliances, and public policy. He has served as a consultant to the Governor's Office of the State of Colorado on strategic planning. He serves as advisor to Denver Rotary, and U.S. Forest Service, among others.

Dr. McGowan has also served as a consultant on organizational change to the Health Care Finance Authority of the U.S. Social Security Administration, Land Title, GE Financial Services, and Great West Life.

Published in numerous journals, Dr. McGowan has co-authored two texts in the area of information systems as well as economic development policy. In 1991, Dr. McGowan was named Methodist Scholar/Teacher of the Year for the University of Denver, and in 1993, he was given the Cecil Puckett Award for Excellence in Teaching within the Daniels College of Business. In 1994, he was named Professor of the Year at the Women's College, University of Denver.

He received his Ph.D. from Syracuse University, M.P.A. from George Washington University, and a B.A. from West Virginia University, Cum Laude.

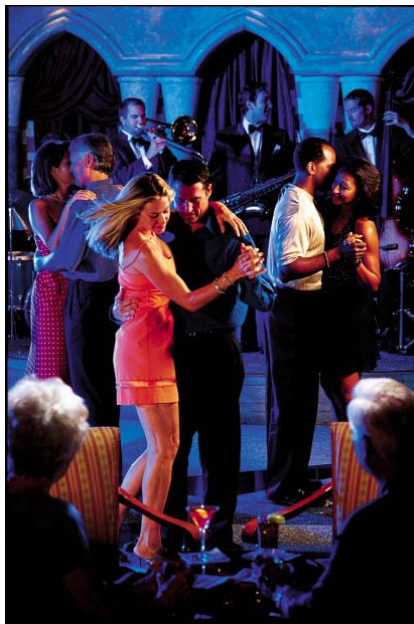
