

The Women's College Alumnae Association Announces the 2012 TWCAA Annual Scholarship

The Women's College Alumnae Association (TWCAA) offers a minimum of one TWCAA Scholarship each year to any currently enrolled, full or part-time, TWC student. The scholarship(s) are awarded based on responses to an essay topic related to women's issues with a focus on education and or career.

The number of scholarships awarded is determined by the amount of money donated to the fund during the year.

The TWCAA Scholarship Committee reviews and scores all complete application packets and selects three finalists, who are then invited to interview. The 2012 TWCAA scholarship recipient(s) must use the scholarship by the end of the 2013 school year.

Applicant criteria:

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Currently enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours.
- Be a continuing or reentering student winter quarter 2012.
- Completed a minimum of 15 credit hours at The Women's College.
- Current minimum grade point average of 3.5.

Applicant information and release:

Applicants must attach a cover page with the following information:

- Full name, student number, address, phone, email, date and title of essay.
- Indicate and provide consent for The Women's College to release GPA to the Committee, including signature line and original signature.

Essay topic:

- *In your opinion which woman (historically or currently) has had the greatest impact on the lives of women today?*

Additional essay instructions:

- No graphics or images in body of essay.
- Two pages, typed, double spaced, 1” margins in 12 point Times-Roman Script.

Scoring and award(s) are based on the following:

- Essay content and form (see topic and instructions).
- Applicant GPA (see criteria).
- Essay format (organization, spelling, grammar and punctuation).
- Applicant interview.

Interviews conducted (tentative):	Saturday, April 7, 2012
TWCAA spring brunch	Saturday, May 5, 2012

TWCAA scholarship recipients are expected to attend The Women’s College Alumnae Association spring brunch on May 5, 2012, to accept the scholarship and share their essay.
