- Total credits required for Graduation: 184
- Maintain an overall grade point average of 2.0 ("C") in all courses
- Maintain an overall grade point average of 2.0 in all courses in the major
- Receive a grade of "C-" or better in courses counting toward the major
- Earn a minimum of 44 credits in business required courses and business elective courses from The Women's College.
- Earn a minimum of 8 credits of business electives from The Women's College
- Business electives must cover a minimum of three disciplines
- When combining all categories of electives, earn no more than 20 credits in one academic discipline beyond the requirements
- Finish the last 45 credits at The Women's College
